WHAT TO DO

Looking for a fun afternoon? Here's a list of nearby places for you to spend your time while visiting TLC.

Phoenicia: (Approx 15 minutes)

Enjoy the local restaurants, shops & boutiques while walking on Phoenicia's Main Street. You'll discover that the town of Phoenicia has pretty much anything you might need during your visit here. And the best part of it is that everything is within a few block's walk.

- Shop for antiques at Country Gallery and Acorn Antique's Craftsman's Gallery on Route 214 off Main Street, or visit Phoenicia Antique Center, the largest in the Catskills
- Tubing is the most popular activity in town. The Esopus Creek follows Route 28 and winds through the bottom of town. Each section takes about two hours to tube so plan accordingly!
- The Catskill Forest Preserve is 300,000 acres of unspoiled woods, and hiking is a great way to see this countryside. Follow the numerous trails, maps of which are available at the Phoenicia Hotel.

Woodstock: (Approx 35-40 minutes)

Browse the shops and eclectic emporiums on Tinker St., visit the art galleries, tour the museum and bike around town. Scenic vistas and babbling brooks meet you around every corner. Take a dip in the Tannery Brook swimming hole or sit back and enjoy the scenery. Encouraging individuality, Woodstock was a large artist colony years before the famous 1969 same-named concert, held in a field 50 miles away.

Kingston Mall: (Approx 35-40 minutes)

If the weather isn't favorable, take a drive to the Kingston Mall to catch a movie or shop around.

The Copperhood Inn & Spa: (Approx 20 minutes)

For a day of relaxation, visit the Copperhood Spa for first-class body and facial treatment.
