

FOR ALL CAMPERS TAKING PRESCRIPTION MEDS DURING CAMP

This summer, Timber Lake Camp is once again **requiring** camp families to register for the service of *CampMeds, Inc.* to dispense and pre-package your child's medication in **pill form** for camp. **TIMBER LAKE CAMP will pay for this service (\$40 per camper)**. *CampMeds* is a safe, fool-proof method to ensure that your child gets the right medication at the right time.

HOW DOES *CampMeds* WORK?

- Pills taken on a routine basis are individually packaged, sealed and sorted according to day and time of administration.
- Each individually sealed packet is labeled with your child's name, medication(s), dosage, date and time to be given.
- Pills that are taken "as needed" will be packaged separately.
- Although you are not required to have *CampMeds* fill prescriptions that are in liquid form, you may choose to do so and they will be sent to camp along with your packaged pills.
- **All meds arrive at camp 4 days prior to your child's arrival and you will be notified by email when they do.**
- *CampMeds* is affiliated with **Reeves-Sain Pharmacy**, which accepts most insurance plans. They will verify your insurance. You will be responsible for any co-payments or deductible as well as the cost of any drugs not covered by your plan.
- **Reeves-Sain Pharmacy** will bill these charges to your credit card during the summer months. If the pharmacy is not a provider for your insurance plan and is unable to get reimbursed, you will be notified prior to billing your credit card. Due to insurance regulations, only one month of medication can be dispensed and sent at a time, no matter how long your child is at camp. **If more than one month of meds is required while your child is at camp, you will need to supply *CampMeds* with a prescription that is written with refills.** Please note: Controlled substances cannot be written with refills and an additional prescription is required. The second month's supply of meds will automatically be shipped to camp. Any unused meds will be sent home by the camp.

HERE'S HOW TO SIGN-UP WITH *CampMeds*:

PLEASE ENCLOSE:

- a. Physician's original prescriptions written for adequate amount of medication for camp stay (30 day increments only)
- b. Copy of both sides of your insurance card
- c. Written directions by either physician or parent for administration of non-prescription meds

ALL OF THE ABOVE ITEMS MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN MAY 24th

A **\$25 late fee** will automatically be charged to your credit card if any of the above is received after the deadline. You are responsible for the cost of all medication changes after a prescription has been filled or packaged.

***CampMeds* FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

1. Exactly Which Medications Am I required to have *CampMeds* Dispense?

- All medication in pill form except for over the counter meds taken as needed. All pills will be packaged.
- If you choose to send *CampMeds* additional prescriptions for meds not in pill form (liquids, inhalers), they will be dispensed accordingly, and sent to camp as well.
- ALL medications must have an original written prescription.

2. Is The Pharmacy On My Insurance Plan?

SeniorMed Pharmacy is contracted with most insurance plans. However, until you submit your registration form with a copy of your insurance card, your plan cannot be verified for billing. We will contact you if the pharmacy is not on the plan. In the rare instance the pharmacy cannot bill your insurance, they will contact you for authorization to charge your credit card. Any credit card charges from SeniorMed will appear after your child begins camp.

3. I Can Only Refill My Child's Medication When He Is Down To His Last Pill. How Can The Pharmacy Send The Meds To The Camp So Far In Advance?

The pharmacy will send the medications to your child's camp BEFORE they bill your insurance. They will not bill your insurance until the day your child begins camp. By doing so, you will not have a problem refilling your child's medication before camp if needed. Since that date will probably NOT coincide with your refill date, the pharmacy will then hold on to the claim form until the appropriate date to resubmit the claim. (They will hold on to the claim form up to 30 days) If your child attends camp longer than 30 days and needs an additional shipment of meds sent to camp, those meds will be billed 30 days after the initial shipment.

4. What If I Pay One Co pay For A 90-Day Supply of Meds?

The pharmacy can only dispense a 30-day supply of medication each month. Please notify *CampMeds* if you have a 90-day plan.

5. Can A Half Of A Pill Be Packaged?

Yes.

6. My Child Takes A Different Dose Of The Same Medication Every Other Day. Can It Be Packaged That Way?

Yes.

7. Will The Pharmacy Dispense Generic Or Brand?

Unless the prescription SPECIFIES, "brand only", the pharmacy will dispense the generic. Most insurance plans only pay for generic.

8. How Do I Get My Physician To Prescribe More Than One Month For A Controlled Substance?

Any state will allow for a physician to write more than one prescription at a time, as long as they are written for no more than a 30 day supply each, and are dispensed only one month at a time. The Physician should NOT post date the prescription. Please visit our website at www.CampMeds.com for a detailed letter you may give your physician on controlled substances.
