Community Care Rx

Who must sign up for Community Care Rx?

Any child who takes a **DAILY** or **AS-NEEDED** medication. That includes **ANY** of the following:

- Prescriptions
- Non-prescriptions/Over-the Counters
- Pills/Liquids
- Creams/Ointments
- Nose sprays
- Eye/Ear drops
- Inhalers
- Fiber Supplements
- Vitamins/Minerals


How do I sign-up ?

By completing the [Community Care Rx Intake Form](#). Registration opens **February 1st** & must be completed by **May 23rd**  (to avoid late fees & to ensure medication arrives prior to the start of camp).

How much does it cost?

\$75 per child per summer. This does not include the cost of the medication.

What else do I need to know?

- The Camper Physician Form includes a 1-page set of instructions for your physician  on how to submit your child's script(s) to Community Care Rx. Be sure to share it with your physician. Alternatively, if you have a physical prescription, you can upload it directly to the Community Care Rx In-Take Form or send via email to their customer service team.
- Community Care Rx initially fills a 30-day supply. **Ask your insurance to allow a vacation override for the summer months.** A 30-day refill will be sent to camp. Any medication not used at camp will be sent home.
- Parents are responsible for all co-payments, deductibles, and medications not covered by insurance.
- Prescriptions for controlled substances cannot be submitted until 30 days prior to the start of camp.

Per New York State Law

ALL MEDICATIONS - including over-the counters & vitamins - must have a physician prescription submitted to Community Care Rx before being dispensed to your child.

Are there any **EXCEPTIONS** where I do not have to use Community Care Rx?

Yes – but very few. They are:

- EpiPens
- Insulin
- Growth Hormones
- Biologics
- Accutane
- Birth Control
- Lactaid
- Multi-vitamins
- GLP-1/GIP Agonists

* *These exceptions still require a physician written prescription (other than true multivitamins)*

** *Chewables are recommended over gummies to avoid melting in the Community Care Rx packaging*

IMPORTANT NOTE – Melatonin, Vitamin D, Calcium & Magnesium **MUST** go through Community Care Rx
