Pack My Rx

Who must sign up for Pack My Rx?

Any child who takes a **DAILY** or **AS-NEEDED** medication. That includes **ANY** of the following:

- Prescriptions
- Non-prescriptions/Over-the Counters
- Pills/Liquids
- Creams/Ointments
- Nose sprays
- Eye/Ear drops
- Inhalers
- Fiber Supplements
- Vitamins/Minerals

How do I sign-up 🐾?

By visiting packmyrx.com. Registration opens **January 1st** & must be completed by **May 28th** 🗓️ (to avoid late fees & to ensure medication arrives prior to the start of camp). If you have used Pack My RX in the past, your login information remains the same, but you will need to create a new “registration” for each summer.

How much does it cost?

\$75 per child, for 60-day supply. This does not include the cost of the medication; **AND**

\$100 Medication Deposit - this deposit goes towards medication costs, including co-pays and over-the-counter costs. Any portion of the deposit that does not get used will be refunded to you in September.

What else do I need to know?

- The Camper Physician Form includes a 1-page set of instructions for your physician 🧑🏻 on how to submit your child’s script(s) to Pack My Rx’s pharmacy partner, **Paw Paw Village Pharmacy**. Be sure to share it with your physician.
- Pack My Rx initially fills a 30-day supply. **Ask your insurance to allow a vacation override for the summer months.** A 30-day refill will be sent to camp. Any medication not used at camp will be sent home.
- Parents are responsible for all medications not covered by insurance and co-pays.

Per New York State Law 📄

ALL MEDICATIONS - including over-the counters & vitamins - must have a physician written prescription uploaded to Pack My Rx before being dispensed to your child.

Are there any **EXCEPTIONS** where I do not have to use Pack My Rx?

Yes – but very few. They are:

- EpiPens
- Insulin
- Growth Hormones
- Biologics
- Accutane
- Birth Control
- Lactaid
- Multi-vitamins (**Note** – Melatonin, Vitamin D, Calcium & Magnesium **MUST** go through Pack My Rx)

**These exceptions still require a physician written prescription (other than true multi-vitamins).*

***Please specify when each medication should be given.**

Controlled Substance Prescriptions

- Must be sent be either electronic script or by mailing the original script to us.
- Scheduled II controlled substances must be submitted to Paw Paw Village Pharmacy by a physician **AFTER** June 1st.
- Each script must be written for #30.
- Two separate 30 day prescriptions need to be sent.

Non-Controlled Prescriptions

- Each script for #30 with refills to last for the camp season.
- All prescriptions should be clear for what **time of day** the medicine should be administered.
- We can package ½ pills if necessary.
- Generics will be dispensed unless brands are specifically requested by physician. If you write “brand name necessary” we will try to bill the insurance for the brand. If the insurance does not cover it, it will be up to the parents to decide if they wish to pay for it.
- Epi-Pens, inhalers, creams and eye-drops will not be packaged in pouches but can be shipped to camp.
- We cannot dispense ANY Growth Hormone, Accutane or Birth Control.
